Blind Ski Clinics:

The May 18th Blind Ski Clinic was canceled due to contaminated rain runoff into Mission Bay as posted on the City of San Diego Website. The June 22 Clinic went well and 3 blind students skied on the Convair boom. One actually got up. The next Blind Ski Clinic will be July 27 and three groups will be participating: The Blind Community Center San Diego, Braille Institute San Diego & San Diego Center for the Blind. About 30-40 students are expected. They will be participating at the beach with a choice of water skiing plus boat and tube rides with lunch at the Mission Bay Boat and Ski Club afterwards for the participants and volunteers. The Boat Club has been providing the sight impaired kids and adults with waterskiing, tube rides & boat rides for 55 years and the Convair Waterski Club has been helping with volunteers and boats for the last 15+ Years. The clinics are held at Hidden Anchorage on Fiesta Island from 9:00 a.m. till 12 noon. Volunteers are needed for each Clinic. The Convair boat TMC will be prepared to supply a boom and a ladder for beginning water-skiers on July 27 just like June 22. Additionally, volunteer helpers are needed to set up from 8am9am and then assist participants with ski equipment, coffee, hot chocolate, donuts then registration of participants and organizing the Sign-up sheets for waterskiing, tube & boat rides. Volunteers are also needed on the water for observing & waterski instruction and supporting the loading and unloading of the participants from the boats. At the club, volunteers are needed to prepare & serve lunch for the participants & volunteers and also to clean & store ski equipment and the boat. TMC

Intermittent oil pump - FIXED Replaced lower exhaust manifold gasket. Traiiler brake actuator - FIXED. Repair pulled through holes and broken section of dash panel. Coast Guard inspection sticker. Install battery hold down bracket. Check that oil reservoir in boat is not leaking. Seems wet around it. Repair and paint engine cover. Repair various chips in boat hull gel coat. Clean/wax/detail boat - 80% complete. Clean boat carpet. Repair speedometers. New pickups needed. Existing ones do not stay down. Investigate why digital reading from lower unit does not work. Suspect the tube from the lower unit to the instrument.
